

Wedding photography always comes with a certain amount of pressure. The photos need to be right because there's no chance for a "do-over" if you miss the shots! A little planning and organization can save the day. Use this list with your photographer to help take away some of the uncertainty.

Before the Ceremony

- Bride alone
- Bride with all parents
- Bride with mother/s
- Bride with father/s
- Bride with sibling/s
- Bride with her entire immediate family
- Same as above plus any spouses and kids
- Bride with grandparents
- Bride with her child/children
- Bride with bridesmaids
- Bride with each bridesmaid
- Bride with flower girls/ring bearers
- Groom alone
- Groom with all parents
- Groom with mother/s
- Groom with father/s
- Groom with sibling/s
- Groom with his entire immediate family
- Same as above plus any spouses and kids
- Groom with grandparent/s
- Groom with his child/children
- Groom with all the groomsmen
- Groom with each groomsman
- Groom with flower girls/ring bearers

Special Shots

Is there anything special the photographer should be aware of that might not be easy to identify? Your grandmother's jewelry, grandpa's hankerchief, etc...

After Ceremony

- Bride and groom together
- Bride and groom with all parents
- Bride and groom with immediate family members from both sides, spouses and kids
- The couple with bride's extended family
- The couple with groom's extended family
- Bride and groom with their child/children
- Bride with groomsmen
- Groom with bridesmaids
- Bride and groom with whole wedding party
- The couple with flower girls/ring bearers
